The Purpose

A Kane County Farm Bureau Foundation community service program, HARVEST FOR ALL provides an avenue to contribute to local hunger relief efforts. 100% of the crop, cash and in-kind contributions to HARVEST FOR ALL are directed to local food pantries of the donor's choosing.

Last year, Illinois Farmers contributed over 4.8 million pounds of food to similar efforts through their local Farm Bureaus. In Kane County, more than 40 local donors to HARVEST FOR ALL contributed over \$13,000 in crop proceeds, cash, and in-kind donations.
